concerning the straying of students during school hours.

**THE MINISTER**

**TO**

**Messrs:**

- **Regional Delegates;**
- **Divisional Delegates;**
- **Heads of institution.**

My attention has been drawn to the fact that during school hours many students, in their school uniforms, hang out in front of the gates of their respective schools and end up roaming the streets of the neighbourhoods, where they engage in various activities. This situation is due to the refusal by some principals to admit latecomers on campus, and to the poor management of the shift system by the schools that practise it.

This situation exposes our students to much deviant behaviour and undoubtedly hinders the attainment of the pedagogical and health objectives that are essential for every academic success.

To rectify this situation, I hereby ask the various authorities to do one of the following in order to correct this:

1. admit all latecomers into the campus and subject them to cleaning activities on campus, while waiting for them to enter the classrooms;
2. ensure the proper management of the shift system;
3. systematically notify parents in the event of temporary or permanent expulsion of students;
4. bring all students from schools practising the shift system to follow lessons in the "Distance Education" platform, outside of the classroom hours.

Please give this circular the utmost importance it deserves.
